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HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

MCAS Beaufort Federal Credit Union is pleased to sponsor scholarships for graduating high school students who are pursuing an undergraduate college or technical degree. These students will be selected to receive an award by a representation of MCAS Beaufort Federal Credit Union and/or the Officers' Spouses' Club by a blind vote based on the following policies and qualifications. The monetary value of the two (2) MCAS Beaufort Federal Credit Union scholarships is \$1,000 each.

POLICY:

- A. These are *tuition scholarships only*. Any applicant who accepts a full scholarship at any college, university or technical school is not eligible to receive this scholarship. Also, an applicant who accepts an appointment to any of the military service academies or a fully subsidized ROTC or NROTC program is ineligible for this scholarship. Applicants receiving any such awards should notify this Committee immediately.
- B. In determining the recipients, the Committee will consider the applicants' scholastic achievement, character, school and community service, extra-curricular activities and plans for utilizing advanced education. MCAS Beaufort Federal Credit Union and MCAS Beaufort OSC do not discriminate or make determinations based on race, color, religion, sex, handicap or national origin.
- C. These scholarships must be awarded to a senior who is currently attending a public or private high school. Home-schooled students who meet all requirements are eligible. The applicant must be an **enlisted** dependent of either a Navy or Marine Corps service member on active duty, retired or deceased.
 1. **If the applicant's sponsor is active duty, the service member must be currently stationed at MCAS Beaufort, MCRD Parris Island or Naval Hospital Beaufort.**
 2. **If the applicant's sponsor is deceased or retired, the sponsor must have been stationed at MCAS Beaufort, MCRD Parris Island or Naval Hospital Beaufort at some time in his/her service career AND the retired sponsor must currently reside in Beaufort County.**



STUDENT QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. Applicants must be in the *upper fifty percent (50%)* of the graduating class.
- B. Applicants must have completed *one full semester* of high school prior to graduation.
- C. Scholarships will be awarded in May 2010. An acceptance letter from the higher education institution of the student's choice must be submitted prior to the distribution of funds.
- D. Applicants must use the award *solely for tuition* in connection with advanced education for him/her with the school year following high school graduation.

REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must submit the following by the deadline of April 23, 2010. If the following requirements are not received by the deadline, your application cannot be considered.

- A. Tuition scholarship *application* (typed or in black ink).
- B. *Activities list*.
- C. *Non-official Transcript of grades including* class rank, guidance counselor's notation and signature.
- D. *Two (2) letters of recommendation*, to include one (1) from a teacher and one (1) character reference from an adult (other than relatives) who has observed the applicant in a role of responsibility. For example, a pastor, coach or employer.
- E. Copy of the applicant's current Uniformed Services ID Card/ DEERS card (front and back).

PROCEDURES:

- A. All eligible applications postmarked on or before April 23, 2010, will be considered. The applications are sorted and compiled by the Scholarship Committee and then presented to the Voting Committee (a representation of the MCAS Beaufort OSC) for a blind vote based on the aforementioned qualifications. The Voting Committee will rate the applications and choose the recipients based on their ranking.
- B. There is one (1) question attached to this application. Please address the question according to the instructions provided.
- C. Names of all applicants will be kept strictly confidential during the voting process. No person from the Scholarship Committee shall serve on the Voting Committee and vice versa.
- D. Recipients will be notified on or before May 11, 2010.
- E. Recipients will be invited to attend the Scholarship Awards Ceremony in May 2010, for presentation of the award. Appropriate news releases will be arranged.



- F. A letter and certificate of award from MCAS Beaufort Federal Credit Union and the OSC Boards will be presented to each recipient at the awards ceremony.
- G. An acceptance letter from the recipient's college is required prior to disbursement of funds. At the beginning of the recipient's first semester of higher education, the actual check for the scholarship will be sent to the institution, chosen by the recipient, with a letter explaining administration.
- H. If the recipient accepts a scholarship but becomes unable to complete the first full semester of higher education, the institution will be asked to return the balance of any scholarship funds remaining.
- I. If the recipient becomes unable to accept a scholarship, the next rated recipient will be selected and notified.
